DIVISION I HORTICULTURE

All specimen classes are OPEN; you may enter TWO ITEMS but they must be different cultivars.
Exception to this rule will be specified where applicable.

Section 'A' Iris

- **Ideal:** 3 or more well placed blooms, evidence of further bloom on strong stalks with good balance
- **Definitions:**
 1. **Bicolour** - Falls of one colour and standards of another distinct colour
 2. **Bitones** - Falls of one tone and standards of another tone of the same basic colour
 3. **Plicata** - Stitched or stippled margin of colour on white background

1. Iris, Tall Bearded, colour1 stalk
2. Iris, Tall Bearded, bicolour - any colour1 stalk
3. Iris, Tall Bearded, bitones - any colour1 stalk
4. Iris, Tall Bearded, plicata - any colour1 stalk
5. Iris, Siberian - 1 cultivar3 stalks
6. Iris, any other cultivar1 stalk
7. Iris, collection of 3 different cultivars (NIP)3 stalks

Section 'B' Peony

8. Peony, Single1 bloom
9. Peony, Japanese1 bloom
10. Peony, Semi-double1 bloom
11. Peony, Double1 bloom
12. Tree Peony1 bloom
13. Itoh Peony1 bloom
14. Peony collection, 3 different cultivars3 blooms

Section 'C' Other Flower Specimens

15. Allium1 bloom
16. Campanula (Bellflower)1 stem
17. Columbine (Aquilegia)1 spray
18. Coral Bells (Heuchera), Leaves, 1 cultivar (NIP)3 leaves
19. Coral Bells (Heuchera), Leaves, 3 different cultivars (NIP)3 leaves
20. Clematis, floating, No foliage (the bloom MUST float)1 bloom
21. Delphinium, any colour (laterals may be removed)1 spike
22. Fern, 1 cultivar3 fronds
23. Hosta (NIP)1 leaf

- 24. Hosta, collection, 3 different cultivars (NIP).....3 leaves
- 25. Iris, Spuria1 stalk
- 26. Iris, any other type.....1 stalk
- 27. Lily, (not Daylily)1 spike
- 28. Lupin1 spike
- 29. Pansy/viola, 1 cultivar (with foliage).....3 stems
- 30. Rose, any other cultivar,1 bloom/spray
- 31. Rose, Fragrant, any cultivar (may be ½ to fully open).....1 bloom
- 32. Rose, Fully Open, floating, No foliage, any cultivar.....1 bloom
- 33. Any annual (NIP)1 stem
