1. Aster, Perennial1 spray
2. Aster, Annual 1 cultivar3 blooms
3. Begonia1 stem
4. Chrysanthemum1 spray
5. Coleus1 stem
6. Dahlia, any colour/typeunlimited entries
7. Gaillardia (Blanket Flower)1 stem
8. Geranium (Pelargonium)1 stem
9. Grasses, Ornamental, one cultivar (NIP).....3 stems
10. Heuchera 3 cultivars3 leaves
11. Japanese Anemone, any colour1 stem
12. Marigold, any size, 1 cultivar3 blooms
13. Phlox, any colour / type1 stem
14. Rose, Hybrid Tea (NIP).....1 bloom
15. Rose, Shrub1 bloom or spray
16. Rose, any other type1 bloom or spray
17. Rudbeckia.....3 stems
18. Salvia, 1 cultivar3 stems
19. Sedum, any variety.....1 stem
20. Sunflower (weighted vase please)1 bloom
21. Any tropical (NIP)(see Definition of Terms) 1 bloom/stem
22. Zinnia (NIP)1 stem
23. Any other annual (NIP).....1 bloom or stem
24. Any other perennial/biennial (NIP)1 bloom or stem
